[Quick Search](#) - Use to search multiple Argosy University Online resources simultaneously.

[A-Z of Online Journal Titles](#) - Search for a specific journal title to find if it is available in AUO's databases.

[EBSCOhost](#) - A collection of all online journal databases from EBSCO in one list, containing thousands of journal articles that cover a wide variety of topics. Includes Academic Search Complete, Business Source Premier and Mental Measurements Yearbook. Good starting place.

[ABI/INFORM Dateline](#) - Local and regional business publications focusing on hard-to-find local and regional business news coverage of large corporations, privately held companies, local start-ups, executive profiles, marketing, finance, and industry news. Provides access to business information not typically found in national news sources. Contains news and analysis, information on local markets, and more gathered from major business tabloids, magazines, daily newspapers, wire services, and city, state, and regional business publications.

[ABI/INFORM Global](#) - Most scholarly and comprehensive way to explore and understand business research topics. Search nearly 3000 worldwide business periodicals for in depth coverage of business and economic conditions, management techniques, theory and practice of business, advertising, marketing, economics, human resources, finance, taxation, computers and more. Information on 60,000+ companies with business and executive profiles.

[ABI/INFORM Trade and Industry](#) - Search more than 1200 business periodicals with a trade or industry focus. Provides users with the latest industry news, product and competitive information, marketing trends, and a wide variety of other topics.

[Academic Search Complete](#) - Full text for over 4650 scholarly publications, more than 3600 of them peer reviewed. Includes topics in the social sciences, humanities, general science, education and most areas of academic study. Good starting place.

[Agriculture Collection](#) - A custom collection of nearly 200 titles focused on agriculture and its related fields: from practical aspects of farming to cutting edge scientific research in horticulture.

[Arts Module](#) - Periodicals on subjects such as arts, dance, theater, and cinema.

[Business and Company Resource Center with PROMT](#) - A fully integrated resource bringing together company profiles, brand information, rankings, investment reports, company histories, chronologies and periodicals. Predicast's PROMT and Newsletter databases are fully integrated in this database. Search this database to find detailed company and industry news and information.

[Business Economics and Theory Collection](#) - This collection of 150 full-text periodicals covers topics such as economic development, forecasting, and history; fiscal theory; monetary theory and financial institutions; business finance; public finance; country studies; and government regulations.
