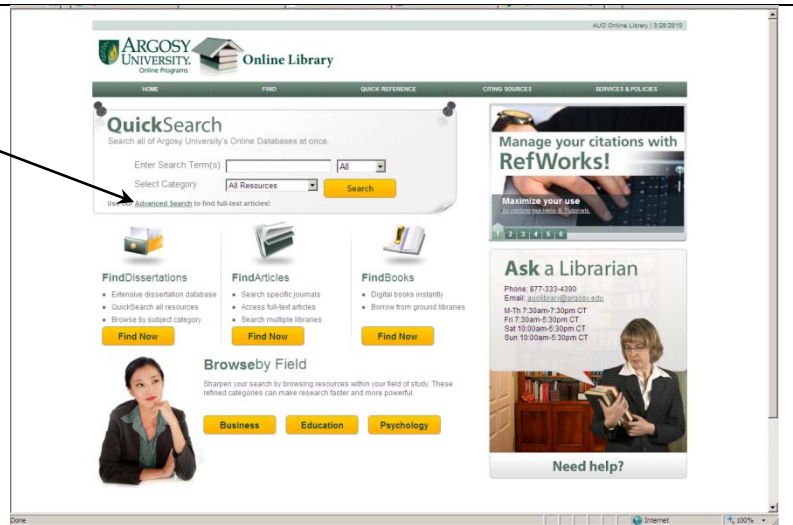

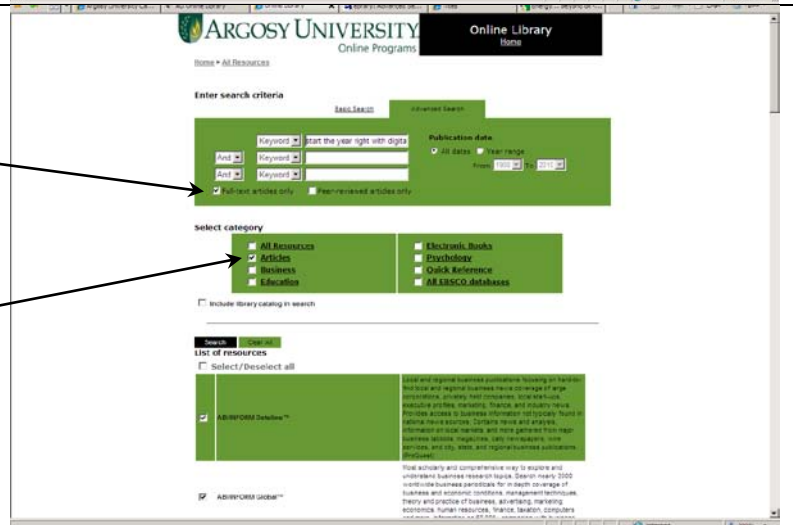
On the Advanced Search page, put checkmarks next to "Full-text articles only"

Select category

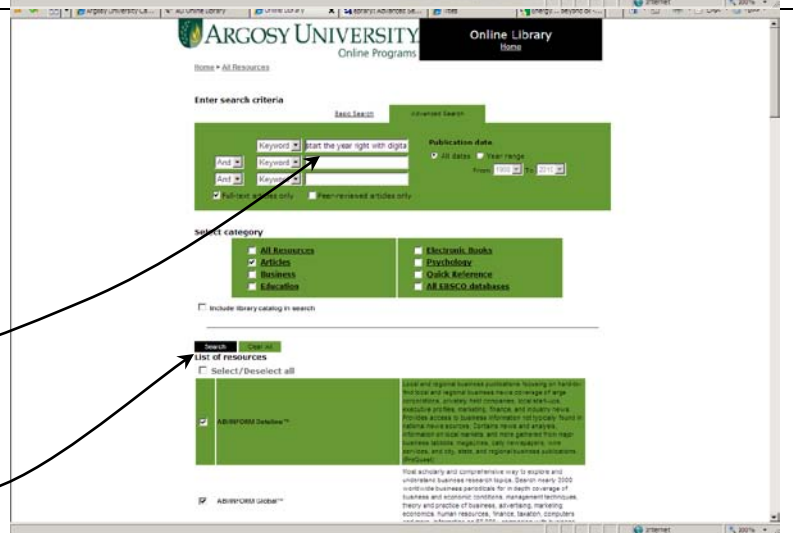
